



## Jobseeker's Visa

This is a visa for university graduates for Non- EU citizens which enables them to come to Germany for up to six months for the purpose of seeking employment commensurate with their qualifications.

After the application has been approved, the German Embassy will issue a residence permit in the form of a visa with the duration for 6 months.

Please prepare the following documents **in the given order**. **Should you wish to keep any originals, kindly provide one additional copy**. Any documents which are not in German/English have to be translated. *Incomplete documentation may result in the rejection of your application.*

<input type="checkbox"/> Valid passport (issued within the last 10 years and valid for at least 6 months after leaving the Schengen area with at least two empty pages)
<input type="checkbox"/> Valid resident card, duration covering at least the visa duration procedure
<input type="checkbox"/> Application form fully completed, duly signed
<input type="checkbox"/> Passport size picture, not older than three months with a bright background and frontal view of the face (please do not attach the picture to the application form). <i>Digitally-altered passport pictures will not be accepted</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> Copy of your passport's data page
<input type="checkbox"/> Copy of your resident card (both sides)
<input type="checkbox"/> Curriculum vitae of professional career, specifying the certificates, diplomas, etc. you have obtained.
<input type="checkbox"/> German university degree or recognized foreign degree comparable to a German degree (depending on the country where the degree has been issued: legalization or an Apostille might be needed). <i>You can check whether your foreign university degree is recognised or comparable by consulting the ANABIN database: <a href="http://anabin.kmk.org/">http://anabin.kmk.org/</a></i>
<input type="checkbox"/> Any additional evidence of your preparations to secure a job that can already be provided

<input type="checkbox"/> A letter of motivation providing information on the planned course of action to secure a job: sector, region, intended place of residence/accommodation
<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of sufficient funds for the whole period of your stay. The proof of sufficient funds can be also provided by a formal obligation (so-called "Verpflichtungserklärung") acc. to sections 66-68 of the Residence Act
<input type="checkbox"/> Visa fee 75 Euro – payable in Lei - cash or card(Visa + Master)

To be provided after the approval of the visa:

<input type="checkbox"/> Flight reservation to Germany, rail tickets, bus tickets, or others
<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of travel health insurance (with headquarters in the EU), valid for the entire stay in the Schengen area with a minimum coverage of 30.000,00 EUR including the following details: name of insured person, length of coverage, insurance sum and repatriation coverage. Please note that health insurance coverage by credit card is not valid unless you present a letter from the credit card company with details of coverage of your trip.

**Please note** that the German Consulate reserves the right to ask for additional documents at any time during processing. Submission of the above mentioned documents does **not** guarantee that a visa is granted.
